CORRIGENDUM

(Passed on 29th day of November 2019)

This Authority had passed an Order No.TAMP/15/2019-VOCPT dated 10 October 2019 disposing the proposal received from the V. O. Chidambaranar Port Trust (VOCPT) for general revision of its Scale of Rates (SOR). The revised SOR and Performance Standards approved by this Authority have been notified in the Gazette of India Extraordinary (Part III Section 4) on 22 October 2019 vide Gazette No.363.

2. The VOCPT vide its letters dated 31 October 2019 and 17 November 2019 have pointed out that there are some errors inadvertently crept in proposed SOR. The VOCPT has, therefore, sought corrections in the revised SOR.

3.1. Therefore, this corrigendum is issued to rectify the errors in the existing SOR of the VOCPT approved by this Authority vide Order No.TAMP/15/2019-VOCPT dated 10 October 2019 which was notified in the Gazette of India on 22 October 2019 vide Gazette No.363. The details of the errors and the corrections made are detailed below:
