ORDER

This case relates to the extension of the validity of the existing Scale of Rates of the India Gateway Terminal Private Limited (IGTPPL) for operation of the Rajiv Gandhi Container Terminal at Cochin Port Trust.

2. The existing Scale of Rates (SOR) of the IGTPPL was published in the Gazette of India on 17 October 2005 vide Gazette No. 145. The validity of the SOR was prescribed till 31 March 2008.

3. The IGTPPL vide letter dated 28 March 2008 has informed that it will file its general revision proposal in a week's time. In the meantime, it has requested to extend the validity of the existing SOR till such time the proposal (to be) filed by the IGTPPL is approved by this Authority.

4. In view of the submission made by the IGTPPL and recognising the time involved in the consultation process and internal scrutiny and analysis after receipt of the proposal from IGTPPL, the Authority accedes to the request of the IGTPPL and extends the validity of the existing Scale of Rates for six month from the date of expiry i.e. till 30 September 2008 or till final disposal of the proposal (to be) received from IGTPPL, whichever is earlier.
